GET READY FOR FIRE SEASON 2020

The upcoming fire season is expected to be much milder this year. This will lead to an increased fuel load, which could cause problems during any dry spells we may get through late spring and summer. Now and the next few weeks is a good time to burn off piles etc, provided you pay attention to the weather, particularly the wind. Still afternoons are the best time, but check around the pile and make sure there is still some moisture present in the surrounding vegetation. Immediately around the pile should be clear. Don't forget to notify fire control and your neighbours that you will be burning and check the weather forecast for wind in the following days before you light up. You can register your burn online using the RFS website. It's easy.

Our new fire station is nearing completion, although we have not yet received a date when we can move in. The COVID 19 pandemic has made training a little difficult, however I would urge all our new recruits not to lose momentum, and get your online training done. - You must have measures in place to control the fire and prevent its spread.

DURING FIRE DANGER PERIOD:

 You must obtain a fire permit from your local permit issuing officer –

- You must follow all conditions on the permit.
- You must maintain a presence at the fire until it is completely extinguished. This means black and cold!

NOTE: You may not burn anything in an open fire in residential areas because of council pollution control laws.
